Our location, service, facilities and friendly staff can guarantee you unforgettable holidays at the country of light Greece.


Location: Agios Avgoustinos, Messinia, Greece.



KALAMATA

Kalamata is the second most populous city of the Peloponnese peninsula in southern Greece and the largest city of the homonymous administrative region. The capital and chief port of the Messenia regional unit, it lies along the Nedon River at the head of the Messenian Gulf.

Kalamata is renowned as the land of the Kalamatianos dance and of the Kalamata olives.

ANCIENT MESSINI

Ancient Messini, is a local community of the municipal unit Ithomi, of the municipality of Messini. Most of the area of Ancient Messini contains the ruins of the large classical city-state of Messini refounded by Epaminondas in 369 BC, after the battle of Leuctra and the first Theban invasion of the Peloponnese.

Currently the substantial ruins are a major historical attraction.

WATERFALLS

Just 25 minutes away from our hotel you will find Polilimnio waterfalls. Polilimnio is an amazing spot full of green, small natural lakes and waterfalls.

The ground's landscapes create plenty of small lakes, some of them like natural swimming pools and waterfalls. The biggest waterfall reaches the height of 20 meters and is called Kadi.
